



Climb the Ferrata Rhinevalley as a team

After a technical briefing in materials science, technology and an introductory team task, we approach the via ferrata. A total of 11 passages have to be mastered. The secured climbing sites alternate with narrow paths. Previous knowledge is not required and you are always accompanied by qualified trainers. More difficult passages can be bypassed if needed via a hiking trail. At the destination you will be rewarded with a rustic restaurant with a great view and Rhenish specialties.

By collaboratively solving and overcoming obstacles, team spirit is strengthened and problem-solving strategies are tested in an unfamiliar environment. In this way sustainable and positive effects can be adapted to the daily work routine.

Meeting point is at the venue. On site, we will introduce you to the program, and if necessary, you will be divided into teams. We will then explain everything you need to know about materials and safety techniques. Previous knowledge is not required! You get professional support from longtime coaches.

We will support the cohesion of the group with team tasks and accompany you professionally. In between there is a reasonable break with fantastic views and an outdoor snack.

After reaching the finish, the day will end together with food and drink. Optionally at the end and highly recommended: a rustic wine tasting with a nice restaurant.
